## HOW TO PRESENT CHANGE CONF

#### **TO YOUR PASTOR:**

Presenting new ideas can sometimes be a challenge, so let's make sure you have the right people supporting you. To get the ball rolling, the first person you will need support from is your Lead Pastor. With their support it will be much easier to gain the support of parents, students, and other board members. This should be done early on to allow time for questions and sharing. Here are some suggested ideas for starting the conversation:

- Show the Promo Video
- Explain how Change Conference can change the lives of your youth and ministry
- Be up front with ticket pricing and the early bird deadline. If you have to fundraise for the event, we encourage you to come with suggestions on how that can be done
- Consider ways to get the whole church community to participate and support their youth

#### **TO YOUR YOUTH GROUP:**

Get your youth group pumped up about Change Conf. We encourage you to challenge your students to invite their non-Christian friends to come to Change Conference.

- Use the promo materials available on our website (including our promo video and media kit <u>changeconference.com/tools</u>)
- Talk about the bands and speakers who will be at the event
- Pump up your group by playing KB & Hulvey at youth group and get to know their music!
- Have your youth tell stories from past events at youth group
- Make it as cheap as possible for the students. Have your group work together to fundraise!
- Connect with us by tagging us in your posts <u>@changeconference</u>

#### **TO YOUR PARENTS:**

If you want your youth to attend Change Conf, their parents need to first say yes! Here are some ways to get the parents excited for what God is going to do through the weekend:

- Have your lead pastor share with parents the importance of Change Conference (have them write a letter, etc)
- Show them the promo video and direct them to the website
- Ask parents to pray that God would reach the heart of their child and the entire youth group
- Have your youth tell stories from past events at youth group
- Think through all of the potential questions they could ask so you are prepared. If you need help answering any other questions, feel free to ask us!

# BUDGETING

Before announcing Change Conf, you'll want to plan your budget so that you can give a cost that includes all the expenses: hotel, transportation, food, and registration.

#### TRAVEL

If you're bringing a smaller group, see if you can partner with another group in your area to charter a bus together. To find the best deal, obtain quotes from several companies before choosing one. Schedule travel time to allow a little extra time in case of emergency and arrive with plenty of time to check-in at the conference. Keep in mind that there is always heavy traffic on the Friday night! Always remember to take advantage of all of the travel time in the car/bus, and use this time to build relationships. The drive home can also be a great time to have good conversations and unpack what took place at Change Conf.

#### FOOD

Our Pre-Party and Leaders Meeting begins at 7pm on the Friday Night. You can choose to have students pack a meal for the car ride or stop for a quick bite before arriving. Please have your students eat breakfast before arriving on Saturday. Free snacks will be provided during the breaks. We will also have a tuck shop available so students can purchase additional snacks and drinks as they choose. There are many restaurants within walking distance to The Church on the Queensway for the Lunch and Dinner break. Many groups love walking across the street for cheap food at IKEA. Try to estimate how much each meal will cost so the students will know in advance.

## **FUNDRAISING IDEAS**

- Bake Sale (Have students bake goodies and sell them after church service. Instead of charging per item, have the church members pay a "donation" per plate)
- Sell chips, candy, etc after youth
- Car Wash
- Ask congregation members to sponsor a ticket
- Ask the senior pastor if the youth could lead the Sunday morning service. If your leadership is comfortable with it, ask that a special offering be taken up on behalf of your youth/youth ministry

Don't forget to have the students be involved. Also, don't be afraid to ask the church for donations! Ask your pastor if you can have a student share from the front how their life has been changed at a conference before.



## **PRAYER GUIDE**

#### **PRAY FOR YOUR GROUP**

- A week or so before the event, gather your youth leaders and pray for each student specifically by name who will be attending the event
- Organize a night for your students to pray together for their non-Christian friends who will be attending
- Pray for safety for your group as you travel to and from the event
- Pray that God will speak to each of your students and that the Holy Spirit will be at work in their hearts
- Pray for your youth leaders: that this weekend would be a time of encouragement and growing even closer with God

#### **PRAY FOR THE EVENT**

- Join us for a day of Prayer & Fasting on October 4th 2023
- Sign up to receive our prayer texts & join our 24 Days of Prayer starting October 4th 2023. Text "PRAYER" to (226) 240-9938 to sign up
- Pray for our Friday Night speaker, Andrew Beresford, that God would speak through him and touch the hearts of all of the youth
- Pray that all of the youth will be listening when the Gospel message is shared on the Friday night
- Pray that hundreds of youth will accept Jesus as their Saviour or re-commit their lives to following Him
- Pray for all the main stage speakers, artists, and breakout speakers
- Pray for Brooke Nicholls and her band as they lead us in worship
- Pray for safety for all groups on their way and at the conference
- Pray that Change Conf is a weekend of refreshment and encouragement for all of the youth pastors and youth workers attending

# WEEKEND SURVIVAL KIT FRIDAY NIGHT CHANGE PARTY

- If you arrive on a bus... a member from our team will come onto the bus when you arrive and give you instructions on where to go to exchange your tickets for your group's wristbands.
- If you arrive in cars... please have yourself or a youth leader ONLY (no youth) go to the outdoor registration tent to exchange all tickets (either printed or on mobile device). The volunteers will scan each of your tickets and provide you with a wristband for each ticket. From there, you can give your students a wristband and they can get into line.
- If you are purchasing tickets at the door... have yourself or a youth leader (no students) go into the main doors to the Box Office. You can pay by cash, debit, or credit card (no Amex) at the doors unless it is sold out.
- You'll want to be in the sanctuary by 6:30pm. Our Pre-Party is from 7 to 7:30pm for all of the youth in the main sanctuary. While the youth are at the Pre-Party, you and your leaders are invited to our Youth Leaders Meeting. In this meeting we will discuss exactly how the Gospel message will be shared and what the students will be directed to do once they have made a decision. We will also take some time to pray for the students who are going to be there that night. While you are there, help yourself to a coffee and snacks! (You're going to need the energy!)

# WEEKEND SURVIVAL KIT Saturday conference

- Doors open at 8:30AM. If you are planning to purchase tickets at the door, our Box Office opens at 8AM, unless we're sold out.
- Just for youth leaders: please join us in the Change Conf/YWC Leaders Lounge! Located in the Fellowship Hall (down the hall towards the gym, on the left). The Leaders Lounge is open during both breaks, lunch and dinner. Eat tons of free food, meet other youth leaders, and maybe even win a prize!
- Prayer Room: We have a prayer team ready to pray with you and your students during our Saturday Conference, open all day.
- Take advantage of the lunch and dinner breaks and have your students review what they learned in the previous session. During the session, jot down some questions you can ask your students afterwards based on what the speaker was challenging the students on.
- The conference wraps up around 7:45 PM. It's important to stay until the end of the final session, as the speakers practically challenge the students at the end of their message. The final session has proven to be a very powerful moment for both students and their leaders.
